

Cognitive Behavioral Training Program

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION – an intensive behavioral training program that takes place at the Mississippi County Regional Juvenile Detention Center. This program offers a secure, stable environment for the juvenile as well as mental health treatment, mentoring, education and drug & alcohol education/awareness. The juvenile is detained in the Mississippi County Juvenile Detention Center for the entire length of the program which is generally 14-30 days long. 30 days is the maximum length for this program. This program is mostly used as a last step prior to the juvenile being committed to the custody of the Missouri Division of Youth Services.

LENGTH OF STAY- The length of stay is determined by the status of the youth before the court.

- Pre-Dispositional – 14 days (minimum) - up to 30 days without returning to court for extension.
- Post-Dispositional – 21 days (minimum) -up to 30 days without returning to court for extension.
