

STUDENTS ON THE RIGHT TRACK (SORT)

This is a program for at-risk youth in the 33rd Circuit (Scott and Mississippi Counties). This program is similar to Big Brothers/Big Sisters. The goal of this program is to get at-risk juveniles off the street during the evening and night hours, get them around positive influences and teach them life skills.

This program meets as follows:

- Tuesdays: 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm in Charleston
- Tuesdays: 4:30 pm - 7:30 pm in Scott City
- Thursdays: 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm in Sikeston (Tanner Street Church of God/south gym entrance)

This program contains several aspects each night which include, but are not limited too:

- Homework Lab
- Free Tutoring
- Free Dinner
- Cooking Education
- Topic based programming (bullying, stress, safe sex, anger management etc....)
- Guest Speakers
- Mentoring
- Recreation Time

Your child's juvenile officer will refer your child for this program if they think it would be beneficial for your child. This program is designed for children ages 11 to 16. Children will be able to come both nights per week or one night a week depending on what their Juvenile Officer assigns them.
